NEGOTIATING PROPOSAL

The objective of the project is to set up a pilot system for the interoperability of the Civil Act Registries, for the exchange of certificates and data through EU offices. Therefore one of the main objective of the project is to accelerate or enable the electronic exchange of acts and certifications between Public Administrations.

Immediate transmission of the Civil Acts - following the international standard of information security – will be advantageous for the Administration as well as the citizen satisfaction level, who will be no more obliged to long and expensive procedures to obtain the Civil Acts of their life central events.

The objective is to allow the immediate update of the individual information on the citizen interested through the transmission of the Civil Acts from one European Country Administration to another.

Through the transmission and the exchange of electronic documents among the Civil Acts Registries of the different Countries, it would be sure that the events about their citizens living abroad are correctly updated and registered in the inner card file: births, filiations, weddings, divorces, deaths, changes about citizenship, about citizens of the Municipality happened out of his country, will be transmitted in real time to permit to the Administration to have an exact and updated situation about all its citizens.

Mayor project objectives are:

- For the Administrations, gaining in efficiency in terms of immediate knowledge that a citizen has had a son abroad, or got married, or died in another Country, to manage in a very short time the information on benefits, changes, etc., connected to the events of the civil acts.
- For the Citizens, the possibility to obtain in a very short time Civil Acts. This will allow to European citizens to reply on time to the request of documentation for inscription to schools universities, employment opportunities, public administrations duties, etc.
- Effectiveness of the relationship Citizen-Administration. The request of certification of civil acts from a citizen of a country A, who lives in a country B, should be satisfied in a efficient way and adequate time lap, what is a appreciable improvement of the relation Citizen-Administration.
- Equal opportunity and democratic participation for all European citizens is another objective of this project. A growing number of European citizens live among the different European Countries, and it is important that the exchange of Civil Acts is constant and continuous.
